Abstract

Research works on aquatic insects never been attracted the south Indian scientists with least exceptions. In order to create awareness and the urge for the need of importance of documenting aquatic insects of Western Ghats, we prepared a checklist on Ephemeroptera. 49 species from Ephemeroptera were recorded. This list will enlighten the future researchers to realize the importance of conservation of Mayfly in Western Ghats.

Introduction

Western Ghats is one among the hot spots in the world and facing severe threats from human inhabitation and intervention. Several aquatic insect species are facing extinction. The most affected groups of documented insect extinctions are Lepidoptera and aquatic insects (Thakur and Kumari 2008). Documentation on aquatic insects in Western Ghats is poor and scanty. However, exhaustive list on Ephemeroptera was given in various journals which are inaccessible to young researchers in India. In order to fulfill the gap, there is an urgent need to publish a species list on Mayfly (Ephemeroptera: Insecta) of Western Ghats are inevitable.
