DESIGNATION OF TYPE SPECIES FOR 2 GENERA OF SIPHLONURINAE (EPHEMEROPTERA: SIPHLONURIDAE) — (Note). Two genera of Ephemeroptera established by Bengtsson (1909. Lunds Univ. Arsskr., N.F., Åfd. 2, 5(4): 1-19), Potameis and Siphlurella, have had no type species designated for them. These are the only known genera of mayflies established before 1931 which lack type species; the International Code of Zoological Nomenclature does not recognize the validity of genera established after 1930 without a designated type species. In this note I designate type species for both genera.

Siphlurella Bengtsson, 1909: 11 (type species by present designation: Siphlurella thomsoni Bengtsson [=Siphlonurus (Siphlurella) linnaeanus (Eaton)]). Siphlurella has most recently been treated as a subgenus of Siphlonurus by Jacob (1974. Ent. Nachr. 18: 1-7).

Potameis Bengtsson, 1909: 13 (type species by present designation: Potameis elegans Bengtsson [=Parameletus chelifer Bengtsson]). Potameis is a synonym of Parameletus Bengtsson (Hubbard 1977. Proc.
